Access at rear of property, follow footpath round to rear of building

Middleway Meeting Hall, Churchill Way, Middleway, Taunton, TA1 3QW

From Police Station turn left immediately after Police Station into Westgate St and follow road round and up the hill. The Hall is at the top of the hill, set back from the road, after the post box, telephone kiosk and bus stop, turn left into Churchill Way (second Churchill Way turning) and take next left to rear of hall. **Or** you can take Trull Road and turn left into Sherford Rd, 2nd left into Middleway then 1st right into Churchill Way. Take next left to rear of hall.

We are so grateful to all at Monks Yard for their continued support

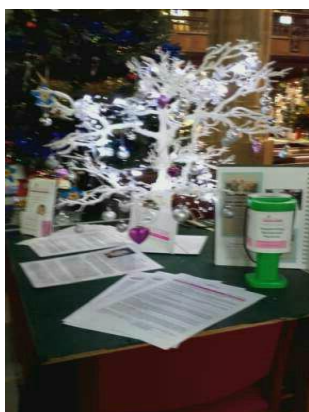
Mayfair Town & Country, Ilminster
